Many of you suggested building in anti-social behaviour deterrents


Several suggested ensuring the tiling is not slippery when wet


You encouraged plants that are considerate of the Barbican wildlife


The majority of you agreed with removing the Yellow Link Building

Frequently Asked Questions

What will the construction hours be?

Noisy works will be limited to the City of London's Noisy Working Hours of 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 9am to 2pm on Saturdays.

Will the works be undertaken in stages?

There will be at least six stages to the works for Phase 2, minimising disruption to podium users.

Will the cost of works result in a service charge increase?

No, the works are not funded by service charges receipts.

Will drainage infrastructure be included as part of the works?

Surveying the drainage infrastructure is a fundamental part of the scope of works for Phase 2. The survey team for drainage is currently investigating the podium area for Phase 2 to identify pipework that may need to be repaired or replaced.

M&E Works Update

Mechanical and Engineering works in the Exhibition Halls are progressing well and are on track.

As you may be aware, the existing transformer from the Exhibition Hall was removed on 6 October 2021 and a new transformer is due to be installed.

The new transformer is due for delivery on 25 October 2021. This work will require a large lorry parked at 86 Golden Lane. A road closure will be in place for this delivery as it did with the removal of the transformer on 6 October 2021 but will only be in place for a couple of hours.
